XLR connectors.

PA-System for the audience

- 3 stools without armrests
- 2 distribution board (3x230V)
- 3 monitor wedges (Violin no monitor)
- 2 mic stands for the guitars (small ones if possible)
- 1 mic stand for the announcement mic
- 2 condenser mics for miking the guitars (if condenser mics are not available 2 Shure SM57)
- 1 Condenser Mic for Violin (just in case), Benjamin brings his own DPA headset.(XLR out)
- 1 Shure SM58 or similar for the announcements

Infos for the technician:

We play acoustic guitars with build-in pickups straight to our amps. Please mix the signals of the microphones in front of the guitars with the pickup signals (XLR) from our amps. 70% microphone and 30% pickup sound is suggested, the more mic-signal the better. The two bass-signals come from a preamp (EBS microbass II, Please provide a proper earthed 48V phantom-powered XLR) as well as from the bassamp via direct out (XLR). In some occasions the preamp signal has to be phase reversed, depending on the setup of the FOH-system.

Please have the guitar-mics, monitor wedges and FOH feedback-checked (einpfeifen!) on artist arrival.
